The successful candidate will work closely together with the Principal Investigator, Dr. Ignasi Martí (<u>https://www.esade.edu/faculty/ignasi.marti</u>) and will join a highly active research environment. The post-doctoral research will be part of Esade Institute for Social Innovation (<u>https://www.esade.edu/faculty-research/en/institute-social-innovationp</u>).

Project description:

A researcher position is requested to join a team investigating neighborhoods, solidarity and the housing crisis in Spain at the ESADE Institute for Social Innovation, together with Professor Ignasi Martí (and director of the ISI). Some research is already underway and new project proposals are being considered. Ethnographers are particularly welcome.

Functions:

The main tasks to be performed by the postdoctoral researcher are related to:

- Collaborate in ongoing projects, together with the team, in carrying out field work, data analysis.
- Identify potential agents and partners for this line of research.
- Participate in the writing of research outputs, academic articles and reports.
- Participate in the design and preparation of project proposals within this line of work for different calls to be presented in the coming months.

Profile requirements:

We are looking for a candidate who holds a PhD in anthropology, sociology, geography, management and related fields. The candidate must have excellent qualitative methods research training, being ethnographic approaches particularly welcome. Being able to speak Spanish is quite important for the position, although not a condition.

At the moment of recruitment, the candidate must comply with the following requirements:















- Be under 30 years of age
- Be unemployed and registered as a job-seeker on the Catalan Job Service (SOC)*
- Must not have carried out research activities at the Ramon Llull University (URL) in the previous six months.

(* see special note below).

We offer:

The full-time position is based at the Esade's Sant Cugat campus (a short metro ride outside the city of Barcelona, Spain), with an annual salary of €30.000 (gross) for a duration of 24 months. There will be no teaching duties.

The starting date for the position is negotiable but no later than 1st of December 2022.

Selection procedure:

- **Submission of applications**: interested candidates should submit: (i) a curriculum vitae; (ii) a short motivation letter outlining their suitability for this position.
