The Research Assistant will be part of Esade Institute for Innovation and Knowledge Management ([link](#)), led by Dr. Ivanka Visnjic ([link](#)). They will have the opportunity to work with several Institute professors and researchers and be involved in the development and management of the research projects related to digitalization, sustainability, smart cities and deep tech in healthcare. These project focus on the interplay of digital technologies (e.g., Internet of Things, Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain) and areas related to grand challenges (e.g., climate change, healthcare).

Functions:

The main tasks to be performed by the Research Assistant are related to:

- Grant writing
- Quantitative and qualitative data analysis
- Coordination with institutional stakeholder
- Coordination with corporate partners
- Organization of workshops and seminars
- Dissemination of knowledge (e.g. via press, social media, etc.)

Profile requirements:

We are looking for a person with excellent analytical skills, both quantitative and qualitative. The researcher will also require excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Being able to speak Spanish is not essential for the position. Capacity for autonomous organization of workload and adaptation to circumstances, a strong sense of responsibility and adherence to strict deadlines.

At the moment of recruitment, the candidate must comply with the following requirements:

- Be under 30 years of age
- Must not have carried out research activities at the Ramon Llull University (URL) in the previous six months.
- Be unemployed and registered as a jobseeker on the Catalan Job Service (SOC). Here is further information on this condition:

- Please note that foreign nationals of a country of the European Union (EU) or of the European Economic Area (EEA) may register as jobseekers as long as they have the "EU Citizen Registration Certificate". When an EU or EEA citizen has been in Spain for less than three months, you can register with your passport or with your valid identity document.

We offer:

The full-time position is based at the Esade's Sant Cugat campus (a short metro ride outside the city of Barcelona, Spain), with an annual salary of €25.000 (gross) for a duration of 24 months.

The starting date for the position is negotiable but no later than 1st of December 2022.

Selection procedure:

- **Submission of applications:** interested candidates should submit: (i) a curriculum vitae; (ii) a short motivation letter outlining their suitability for this position.
